Observation Schedule July 11, 2017 City of Chino Special Election

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **June 12, 2017** The processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **June 14, 2017** The Logic and Accuracy Testing of the County's voting systems begins at 10 a.m.
- July 7, 2017 The counting of Mail Ballots begins at 9 a.m. and continues periodically, Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **July 11, 2017** The counting of Polling Place Ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **July 12, 2017** The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before August 10, 2017.
- July 13, 2017
 - The random precinct selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 10 a.m.
 - The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
- **July 19, 2017** The random batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 9 a.m.
- **July 20, 2017** The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 10 a.m.
