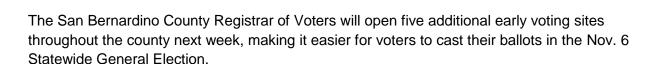

## Early voting expands for the 2018 Statewide General Election







The Registrar of Voters has been accepting votes since Oct. 9 by mail and from voters who come into the Registrar's office. As of Thursday, 73,410 ballots had been cast.

Doors will open Tuesday morning at early voting sites in Apple Valley, Lake Arrowhead, Montclair, Victorville, and Yucca Valley.

Eligible citizens who missed the voter registration deadline on Oct. 22 still have an opportunity to exercise their right to vote through the conditional voter registration process.

Individuals must complete and submit a voter registration application at the Registrar of Voters Office or any early voting site up until Election Day. The voter will then be given a provisional ballot to cast.
