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### Mail ballot application deadline is Tuesday, Oct. 30

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The deadline is Tuesday for San Bernardino County voters to sign up to receive a mail ballot in the November 6, 2018 Statewide General Election.

Voters may submit an online application at [SBCountyElections.com](http://SBCountyElections.com), fill out the Mail Ballot Application found on the back cover of their Voter Information Guide, or call the Registrar of Voters at (800) 881-VOTE (8683) or (909) 387-8300.

Voted mail ballots may be returned:

- By mail so long as it's postmarked on or before Election Day, Nov. 6, and received no later than three business days after the election,
- To any mail ballot drop-off location,
- To any polling place on Election Day, or
- To any early vote site.

To find a mail ballot drop-off location, voters can use the Mail Ballot Drop-Off Map located on the office's website at [SBCountyElections.com](http://SBCountyElections.com).

Voters can find their assigned polling place:

- On the back cover of their Voter Information Guide.
