Elections Office Open Until Midnight for Voter Registration Deadline



Monday, October 20, 2014, is the deadline for San Bernardino County residents to register to vote in the 2014 Statewide General Election. The Elections Office of the Registrar of Voters, 777 East Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, 92415, will be open until midnight on October 20 to accept last minute voter registration applications. Residents can also register online at www.sbcountyelections.com.

“We’re trying to make voter registration as convenient as possible,” said Michael Scarpello, Registrar of Voters. “San Bernardino County residents can register online, or they can pick up a paper registration at more than 150 locations across the county. In addition, we will stay open until midnight on Monday to give people as much time as possible to register.”

Residents can pick up paper registration forms at locations throughout San Bernardino County such as post offices, city clerks’ offices, and the Department of Motor Vehicles. A map of those locations is available on the Elections Office website.
