Observation Schedule 2014 Statewide General Election

The 2014 Statewide General Election will be held on November 4, 2014.

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- October 16, 2014 Processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- October 17, 2014 The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- October 20, 2014 Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County's voting systems begin at 10 a.m. and continues on October 21, 2014, at 10 a.m.
- October 28, 2014 Counting of Mail Ballots begins at 9 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **November 4, 2014** Counting of Polling Place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- November 5, 2014 The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before December 2, 2014.
- **November 10, 2014** The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m.
- **November 12 2014** The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
