**Don't Forget to Return Your Mail Ballot
Mail, Drop Off, or Drive-Thru**

The San Bernardino County Elections Office urges voters to return their mail ballots on time for the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election.

There are several ways to return a mail ballot:

- Mail via the U.S. Postal Service by Wednesday, October 31, 2012 to ensure timely delivery to the Elections Office at 777 East Rialto Ave., San Bernardino, CA 92415. Postage is 65 cents. Ballots must be received by 8 p.m. on Election Day in order to be accepted. A ballot postmarked on Election Day, but not received in the Elections Office, will be rejected.
- Drop it off at any city clerk's office or any San Bernardino County library during regular business hours through Election Day. Use the online [Mail Ballot Drop-off Map](#) at www.sbcountyelections.com to find the locations on a map.
- Drop it off on Election Day at any one of the County's 444 polling places.
- Deliver it to one of three drive-thru drop-off locations:
