## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Observation Schedule State Senate District 23 Special Primary Election

The State Senate District 23 Special Primary Election will be held on March, 25 2014.

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **March 6, 2014** – Processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete. Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County's voting systems will be held at 10 a.m. and is estimated to take two hours.
- **March 7, 2014** – The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **March 20, 2014** – Counting of Mail Ballots begins at 9 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **March 25, 2014** – Counting of polling place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **March 26, 2014** – The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before April 4, 2014.
- **March 28, 2014** – The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m. The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
