PUBLIC NOTICE

Observation Schedule February 2, 2016 Elections

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **January 12, 2016** – The processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **January 15, 2016** – The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **January 20, 2016** – The Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County's voting systems begins at 1 p.m.
- **January 28, 2016** – The counting of Mail Ballots begins at 9 a.m. and continues periodically, Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **February 2, 2016** – The counting of Polling Place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **February 3, 2016** – The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before March 3, 2016.
- **February 4, 2016** –
 - The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m.
 - The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
