#### Observation Schedule

#### March 17, 2015 State Senate District 21 Special Primary Election

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the State Senate District 21 Special Primary Election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **February 17, 2015** – Processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **February 25, 2015** – Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County’s voting systems begin at 10 p.m. (Selected members of the public are invited to participate)
- **February 27, 2015** – The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **March 3, 2015** – Counting of Mail Ballots begins at 9 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **March 17, 2015** – Counting of Polling Place ballots begin shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **March 18, 2015** – The Official Canvass of the Election begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before March 27, 2015.
- **March 19, 2015** – The 100 Percent Manual Tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units begins at 10 a.m. (Selected members of the public are invited to participate)
- **March 20, 2015** – The One Percent Manual Tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m. (Selected members of the public are invited to participate)
