## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Observation Schedule Assembly District 52 Special General Election

A Special General Election in the Assembly District 52 will be held on September 24, 2013.

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **August 30, 2013** – Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County’s voting systems will be held at 10 a.m. and is estimated to take two hours.
- **September 3, 2013** – Processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **September 6, 2013** – The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **September 13, 2013** – Counting of Mail Ballots begins at 8 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **September 24, 2013** – Counting of polling place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **September 25, 2013** – The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before October 22, 2013.
- **September 26, 2013**– The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
- **September 27, 2013**– The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m.
